ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS AS NO PARKING ZONES DURING SNOW EMERGENCIES

AND NOW, be it ordained and enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of West Cocalico Township, as follows:

- 1. The parking of vehicles of any sort upon the cartway of the designated streets hereafter provided during snow emergencies (for purposes of this ordinance a "snow emergency" is defined as the period of time between the accumulation of any measurable snow or sleet upon a designated street until its substantial removal from same, or between the accumulation of a sufficient amount of ice as to render a designated street hazardous) is hereby prohibited.
- 2. Designated streets within West Cocalico Township upon which parking during snow emergencies is prohibited are:
 - a. Chapel View Drive;
 - b. Redstone Circle;
 - c. Highland Court;
 - d. Parkview Drive; and
 - e. Steeple Court.
- 3. The aforesaid prohibition shall extend to the full length and breadth of the above-named streets during a snow emergency.
- 4. Any person who violates this ordinance is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).
- 5. The Township shall, as soon as reasonably possible after the effective date of this ordinance, erect such signs as shall be reasonably necessary to provide notice of the parking prohibition set forth herein. Such signs shall bear the designation; "No Parking Until Snow Is Removed", and shall otherwise conform in size, shape, design, location, color, and number as may be required by the regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
- 6. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, are repealed.
 - 7. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment.
