The Chairperson, Scott Allen, leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, called the regular meeting of the West Cocalico Township Authority to order at 7:00 P.M. The following were in attendance:

Jim Moyer motioned to approve the minutes from the meeting held on August 12th, 2025. Arlan Hoover seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dave Gingrich motioned to approve the list of checks for the period of 8/13/2025 to 9/9/2025 from the Sewer Fund totaling \$68,757.14. Jim Moyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Clean Water Inc. report for the month of July indicated the average daily flow was 160,800 gallons per day.

Byron Hurst made a motion for the execution and submission of the renewal application for the NPDES permit. Dave Gingrich seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dan Becker stated the Authority will need to purchase phosphorus credits from the Lititz treatment plant after the credits are certified. The certification can occur after September 30th, 2025.

Dan Becker presented the Sewer Engineer's Report:

Joy Christian Fellowship:

Becker is reviewing the revised sanitary sewer design that was submitted on August 15th, 2025.

1940 Texter Mountain Road Sewer Connection:

The work has been completed. The joints need sealed and the line needs to be formally dedicated to the Authority.

Rules/Regulations Update:

Becker met with the Authority staff on September 8th, 2025 for final revisions of the document. The Authority staff has a few tasks to complete for the finalization of the Rules/Regulations document.

Arlan Hoover motioned to approve the list of checks for the period of 8/13/2025 to 9/9/2025 from the Water Fund totaling \$54,138.36. Byron Hurst seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Dan Becker commented concerning the water replacement project. The propagation study was completed. The vendor is recommending one collector on the Tower at Tank 1 or two collectors in other locations. Becker is reaching out to the vendor for more information.

Arlan Hoover motioned to purchase a line locator. Byron Hurst seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kent Reich presented the Water System report for August 2025.

Dan Becker presented the Water Engineer's Report.

There being no further business, Byron Hurst motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 P.M. Jim Moyer seconded the motion. Motion carried.
