The organizational meeting began at 7:00 p.m. with the following in attendance:

Public Comment:

Leon Eby motioned to approve the minutes from meetings on March 9, 2026 and March 17, 2026. Jeff Sauder seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Leon Eby motioned to approve the attached list of checks totaling \$148,498.77. Jeff Sauder seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Leon Eby motioned to approve the use of Township roads for the Chazak race on May 9th. Jeff Sauder seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Leon Eby motioned to approve the use of the Schoeneck Fire Police for the Schoeneck Veteran's Memorial Association Memorial Day parade on May 25, 2026. Jeff Sauder seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Officer Garver presented the Police Chief report. Officer Garver stated the K9 Unit program has started. The program was funded by community groups. The Board of Supervisors discussed concerns about road issues (cars racing, ATV'S, UTV'S, and golf carts on the roads) throughout the Township. There was a discussion concerning adopting Chapter 155 – Curfew. The Board of Supervisors requested having the Solicitor adjust the language before adoption.

Carolyn Hildebrand presented the Manager's report as follows:

1. The Get Outdoors Lancaster program will be using Main Street Park this year.
2. Yvonne Sallade, Josele Cleary and I have been working to achieve compliance at the property at 1730 Texter Mountain Road.
3. The police approached me about adopting a curfew ordinance for minors.
4. Adamstown Library will be having events at Chapel Gate Park on June 19th and at Schoeneck Park on June 26th.
5. I have been working with Josele Cleary to see if BlueScope/Sourcewell is an option for the construction of the new maintenance facility.
6. Steve Stunk and I have been reviewing and interviewing candidates for the Administrative Assistant position which will be available soon.
7. Tom Showalter, Michael Eberly and I attended a virtual meeting to discuss infiltration at the Creamery Road site.
8. I have been working with Josele regarding issues with a Blue Ridge contractor.

Tom Showalter presented the Roadmaster's report as follows:

1. Replaced four pipes and head walls on Forest Road. Three pipes must be replaced on Yellow Mountain Road. The paving on Forest Road will hopefully start late August.
2. Put the snow equipment away.
3. Prepared the mowing equipment.
4. Performed mulching and clean up at the Parks.
5. The test pits were redone at the new building site.
6. Attended CDL training.
7. Replaced a stop sign at Short and Line Road.
8. Working with Clay Township on a pipe issue on West Girl Scout Road. The pipes will need repair in the near future. Tom will be investigating options for repairs.
9. Replaced the transmission in the F-350 truck.

The Zoning Officer's report was presented.
