Municipal Snow Removal Policy

As we approach winter, we are taking this opportunity to provide a summary of the Municipal Snow Removal Policy and share some helpful guidelines:

At the start of the storm, all trucks are sent out to their assigned areas with the instructions to salt hills, intersections and curve areas first, then all other areas. When there is sufficient depth to the storm to warrant plowing, the drivers are instructed to make one pass in each direction on the street and to make one pass in and one pass out in the cul-de-sacs. Heavily traveled roads will be plowed first and then less traveled areas, as well as developments and cul-de-sacs. After each one is passable, the procedure of pushing back the snow to the road edge and cleaning out the cul-de-sacs will begin. This operation may not begin until the following day or days depending upon the severity of the storm. The road crew does their best to keep the roads passable and to not push snow into driveways, around mailbox areas or damage grass in the right-of-way.

Thank you for your patience during the winter season.

Helpful guidelines to follow:

- * Park off the road and in your driveway or in one of our township owned parks. If your driveway is steep or you have multiple vehicles, please park at the mouth of your driveway and off the road. In cul-de-sacs, please park all vehicles off the roadway.
- * Wait to shovel snow from the last five feet of your driveway until the roadway is plowed to full width.
- * Do not put snow on streets or on neighboring properties. It is illegal to shovel or blow snow onto township or state ROADS.
- * For your safety, if there is a fire hydrant on your property, please clear the snow from the hydrant.

SNOW ROUTE

A snow plowing route has been created for: **Boulder Drive, Bridle Path Way, Cedar Court,** Chapel View Drive, Circle Drive, Clearview Drive, Farrow Lane, Green Court, Highland Court, Hill Drive, Hollow Road, Joshua Circle, Krueger Drive, Linda Lane, Martin Circle, Park View Drive, Pebble Lane, Pelham Road, Pheasant Lane, Pine Crest Drive, Red Stone Circle, Sandra Circle, Steeple Court, Sunrise Lane, Village Spring Lane and Walnut Lane

From the time there is an accumulation of any measurable snow or sleet until it has been substantially removed from the streets, <u>NO PARKING WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE DESIGNATED</u> STREETS. THIS APPLIES EVEN WHEN NO EMERGENCY IS DECLARED.

The township **WILL NOT** remind you to move your cars.

During that time, parking will be permitted on grass and sidewalks without ticketing. Additional parking will also be available in Chapel Gate Park, Schoeneck Park and the Township Building.

IF PLOWING STARTS ON YOUR STREET AND THE CARS ARE NOT MOVED, TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED BY THE POLICE

LOW HANGING TREES & SHRUBS

All residents are reminded to take care of any low hanging trees and/or shrubs on their property. If the trees or shrubbery on your property are growing onto or over the roadway, please trim the branches. Tree limbs hinder larger trucks, school buses and snow plows from moving freely on the roadway.

Failure to remove any low hanging trees and shrubs may result in that area not being plowed or the road crew trimming them for you.

MAILBOXES

Checking your mailbox now will keep you worry free all winter when snow plows pass by.

Please ensure your mailbox is secure and does not lean over the curb-line. Mailboxes that lean over the curb-line are more likely to get hit by a snowplow.



Mailboxes and mailbox posts that are loose, rotten or in generally poor condition can be knocked over by heavy snow.

MAILBOXES WILL NOT BE REPAIRED OR REPLACED IF DAMAGED BY HEAVY SNOW.

THE MAILBOX OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF THE MAILBOX IF THE MAILBOX WAS DAMAGED BY THE PRESSURE OF THE PLOWED SNOW, AND THERE WAS NO PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH THE SNOW PLOW EQUIPMENT.

BURN PERMITS

If you are planning to do open burning of woody yard waste/ brush, you will need to pick up a burn permit. Burn permits are only good for a maximum of 30 days. After 30 days, you must obtain a new permit.

Burn Permits are available in the township office Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Safe digging is no accident! If you are installing a fence, deck, or digging for a mailbox post, patio or other excavation project, it is important to:

ON-LOT SEWAGE SYSTEMS

Just a friendly reminder that on-lot sewage disposal systems must be pumped out **every 3 years**.

When your system is pumped, please send a copy of the septic system report to the Township office to be kept on file.

Please do not send a copy of your invoice.

If you have not paid the <u>one-time</u> \$25 fee, please submit that with the pumping report. If you are unsure if you have paid the fee, please call the township prior to making the payment.

BUILDING PERMITS

Permits <u>ARE</u> required for <u>ALL</u> construction projects, as well as a fence, shed, or a change in use of a property.

Permits <u>ARE NOT</u> required for sealing driveways, painting, wall-papering, new flooring, sidewalks, replacement windows, swings, and replacement of siding or roofs (unless there is a structural change)

A representative from Lancaster County Assessment Office <u>MAY</u> visit your property within months to a year after the permit is issued.

This is a separate follow-up inspection
